Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of Central Assistance amounting to Rs. 1798.7635 lacs (Rupees seventeen crore, ninety eight lacs, seventy six thousand, three hundred and fifty only) under Flood Management component of Flood Management & Border Area Programme (FMBAP) and placement of the same at the disposal of Chief Engineer I&FC Jammu and DSE, Kargil for its utilization during the current financial year against the approved ongoing projects as per the details given below and project wise details given in Annexure "A" to this order:-

The release of funds is subject to the following conditions:-

- That in accordance with the Appropriation Act, the funds shall be released through BEAMS and the HoDs will also further release the funds through BEAMS;
- That the funds shall be utilized after observing all requisite codal formalities required as per norms and procedure and shall not be available for re-appropriation / diversion at any level;
- That these funds shall be utilized only against the ongoing projects approved under AIBP (FMBAP) strictly as per the approved components and according to prescribed guidelines of GoI;
- That there shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source such as SDRF, District Plan/Flagship Programme etc;

- e) That Drawing & Disbursing Officer shall satisfy himself about the reasonability of costs, proper quality control, genuineness of work-done claims as per prescribed standards and physical existence of works;
- f) That due diligence is effected & thorough analysis is done to ensure that economy is achieved while making the payments and the claims shall satisfy the touchstone of reasonability of cost in the works estimates, so that State exchequer is benefitted;
- g) That the works shall be executed within approved cost and time to avoid any additional financial implication;
- h) That the funds so released shall not be parked un-necessarily;
- i) That the Chief Accounts Officers of the Office of Chief Engineer shall vouchsafe the utilization of funds as per codal procedure/Gol's guidelines; and
- j) That the utilization certificates be furnished to the Administrative Department as early as possible for claiming the 2nd installment of CA.
