The release of funds is subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the funds so revalidated shall be utilized only on flood affected identified schemes after observing all codal formalities including Administrative approvals and technical sanctions from competent authorities.
2. That the works shall be taken up and completed within the approved cost. No work shall be tendered/allotted beyond the approved allocation.
3. That it is the responsibility of concerned implementing Agencies to ensure and certify that no un-approved/in-eligible works are taken up and revalidation has only been sought for those originally approved works which could not be completed in the last Financial Year.
4. That there shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source such as SDRF, District Plan/CSS/Flagship Programme and duplication in the adoption of works/schemes to obviate any chance of misuse of funds.
5. That the funds so released shall not be parked un-necessarily.
6. That the funds so released shall not be available for re-appropriation/diversion at any level.
7. That no further liability is created and works shall physically and financially completed within the approved cost.
8. That Drawing & Disbursing Officer shall satisfy himself about the reasonability of costs, proper quality control, genuineness of work-done claims as per prescribed standards and physical existence of works.
9. That due diligence is effected & thorough analysis is done to ensure that economy is achieved while making the payments and the claims shall satisfy the touchstone of reasonability of cost in the works estimates, so that State exchequer is benefitted.
10. That pre, during and post execution photographs and video graphic evidences of the works executed be preserved for record and future reference.
11. That the supervision by the Engineering Staff at different levels as per prescribed norms shall be ensured.
12. That monthly progress report indicating scheme-wise progress is furnished to the Administrative department by 10<sup>th</sup> of following month to which it pertains.


