This Cell shall be responsible for collecting all information and keeping liaison with all other concerned Departments, like Revenue, Power Development Department etc., in connection with the various issues arising out of implementation of the Indus Waters Treaty. This Cell shall, inter-alia, ensure that all data is consolidated and supplied to the Ministry of Water Resources, Government of India, New Delhi in time and all matters connected with the implementation of the Treaty are coordinated.

Consequent upon the above, Shri M.L.Nehru, Senior most Executive Engineer (Hyd:) presently attached to the Chief Engineer, Irrigation & Flood Control Department Kashmir, is promoted as Superintending Engineer (3150-4500) on adhoc basis for a period of six months or till clearance by the DPC/PSC whichever be earlier and posted as Special Officer, Indus Waters Treaty Cell.
