The release of Central Assistance is subject to the conditions that :-

- i. The release of funds do not confer the sanction to book the expenditure which should be booked after observing all requisite codal formalities besides strictly adhering to the guidelines of NRDWP;
- ii. The funds shall be strictly utilized as per the decisions taken in the SLSSC meeting held on 27-11-2013, minutes issued whereof vide PW/Hyd/P&S/SLSSC/2013-14 dated 06-12-2013.
- iii. No work should be taken in hand, in anticipation of accord of Administrative Approval/ technical sanction by competent Authority;
- iv. There shall not be any duplication in the adoption of works / schemes and incurring of expenditure thereon to obviate any chance of misuse of funds;
- v. No diversion of funds from one head to another is allowed without prior approval of the Adm. Deptt.
- vi. The CE shall ensure that no new schemes are taken up out of the funds released which have not been approved by the Scheme Level Scheme Sanctioning Committee(SLSSC) besides revision of cost of schemes is not allowed;

vii. The funds shall be further released, immediately to the implementing agencies in proportion to the current years scheme-wise allocation to ensure its utilization and achievement of targets with intimation to the Adm. Deptt.

viii. The CE will further transfer the funds immediately to the Executing agencies through electronic transfer with an intimation to the Administrative Department;
